1. Roll-Call for Participants & Congress

- 14 member countries out of 16 member countries were present.
 - Tajikistan and DPR Korea were absent.
 - 1 Observer from Timor-Leste
- Quorum met
 - Opening of the congress was announced.

2. Greetings

2-1 Welcome Speech by Mr. Gian Franco Kasper, President, FIS

It is a big pleasure to see you all here for the first FIS congress in Mexico. At this FIS congress, main discussion in the agenda is new system of financial support for national ski associations. As you know up to now, we have supported national ski associations financially according to the number of their participating athletes at the championships. It was surely good at the beginning because the cost to participate at the championships was expensive so the support from FIS was helpful. However, there has been some cheating on the number of athletes. Therefore, FIS found new system very focused on activities of national ski associations, not just on the number of athletes. This system, so called "Safety Net", is very fair. It would help to balance out among associations. Most of associations will get more financial support than before in principle. Lastly, I thank to Asian Ski Federation for your good results of Asian Championships, which are very promising because championships have been developed much.

2-2 Welcome Speech by Dr. Sung-Won LEE, President, ASF

Welcome you all in Cancun, Mexico! This is the farthest congress site from Asian continent comparing with other sites in past. Although the weather is extremely humid, Cancun has the famous resorts around this region. The 14th ASF congress is held coinciding with the 50th FIS congress. Thanks to the FIS Development Program, we had two successful Asian Championships for 2 years. Last year, we had the Licensed Championships for the first time in Korea. This year, we had the Children Championships in Lebanon. I thank the Lebanese Ski Federation for their successful championships, especially for their efforts on the military cooperation for the safety of participants and TV media to televise the championships. Once again, I wholeheartedly welcome you all.

2-3 Welcoming New Faces from ASF Member Countries

- **China:**

Mr. Chengliang LIU, Vice President, Chinese Ski Association. It was good for him to have an opportunity to talk with ASF members about the 2022 Winter Olympic Games in China and the 2021 FIS Freestyle Ski and Snowboard World Championships - Zhangjiakou/Genting Resort. He thanked Dr. Lee for the support and help.

- **Iran:**

Mr. Ahmad SAADTMAND, Provisional President until next election of Iran Ski Federation. Mr. Bahram SAVEHSEHSHAKI is now Provisional Secretary General until next election as well.

- **Korea:**

Mr. Jae-Chan (Ignacio) LEE, Vice President, Korea Ski Association. He joined the KSA last year and tried to learn from ASF and FIS as much as he can.

- **Mongolia:**

Ms. Endene OCHIRSUREN, Secretary General informed that former president of Mongolia Ski Federation retired. New president was elected, but he was not participated at this congress.

- **Pakistan:**

Mr. Qaswar Abbas NAQVI, Secretary General, Ski Federation of Pakistan. He was elected last year.

3. Acceptance of Official Minutes of the 13th ASF Congress

The 13th ASF congress was held at Hotel Rey Juan Carlos I in Barcelona, Spain on June 4th, 2014 at the time of 49th FIS congress. The 41 delegates from 15 ASF member countries (CHN, HKG, IND, IRA, JPN, KAZ, KGZ, KOR, LIB, MGL, NEP, PAK, PRK, TPE, UZB) were present.

The minutes had been circulated to member countries on July 14th, 2014 and no other comments have been received. Therefore, the minutes of the 13th ASF congress in 2014 were unanimously accepted at this 14th ASF congress.

4. Reports

4-1 Financial Report

The financial report for 2014-2016 was unanimously accepted with the confirmation of ASF auditors, Mr. Evgeniy NUJDIN of Uzbekistan and Mr. Ming-Sheng KUO of Mr. Ming-Yi UNG of Chinese Taipei which is attached. There were no further views and remarks.

The current ASF finance situation has not been strong. In fact, we established Finance Committee of ASF in past, but it did not work much. Therefore, Dr. Lee suggested the possibility of raising the membership fee to USD500 from current USD300 in future, not right now. This issue would be considered positively for the future of ASF.

4-2 Report on the 24th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Licensed) in Korea in 2015

The 24th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Licensed), which was the first ASF championship for Licensed category, was held at Yongpyong ski resort in Korea during March 3rd – 4th, 2015 under a subsidy program of FIS Development Program. The championships resulted in the participation with the 12 Asian Ski Federation member countries (IND, IRA, JPN, KAZ, KGZ, KOR, LIB, MGL, NEP, PAK, TPE, UZB) with 55 racers and 22 foreign coaches and officials.

Yongpyong is the site for the 2018 PyeongChang Olympic Winter Games. It was a good opportunity for competitors to experience the 2018 Olympic course for GS and SL. The FIS Development Program supported airfare for 4 racers and 1 official per each nation.

For the SL, competition site was moved to the domestic site from the original Olympic site because wind was too strong. It was impossible to use Gondolas so chair lifts were used instead. Championships were conducted successfully.

4-3 Report on the 23rd Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children) in Lebanon in 2016

The 25th Asian Junior Alpine Ski Championships was held at Mzaar ski resort in Lebanon on March 5th – 6th, 2016 under a subsidy program of the FIS Development Program. The championships resulted in the participation with the 8 Asian Ski Federation member countries (IND, KAZ, KGZ, KOR, LIB, MGL, NEP, PAK) with 97 racers and 10 foreign coaches and officials. Under the FIS Development Program, airfare for 4 racers and 1 official were supported per each nation.

The opening ceremony was covered by the Lebanese Media's and the 2 days races (SL & GS) were covered "Live" by 1 TV (future TV). It was notable that the TV covered the races Live for the first time in Lebanon.

The Lebanese Ski Federation is also scheduled to organize next Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) in 2017 in Lebanon.

For the preparation of championships, Lebanese Ski Federation had a hard time because of warm weather. The competition site had to be moved into a new slope where the snow condition was better than the one they planned. It was a nice and successful competition in spite of bad snow.

Mr. Freddy KAIROUZ, secretary general mentioned that Lebanon was very safe country to visit. Accommodations and local food in Lebanon were excellent even for foreign people besides good competition.

5. Discussions

5-1 India

India suggests 4 issues to coordinate training so that Indian athletes can achieve tangible results at world level.

- (1) To request ASF President to visit India to advise Indian Govt. for the development of the desired infrastructure. As India does not get any sponsors, ASF President needs to give special concessions to our ski athletes for FIS races within the Asian continent.
- (2) Special vacancies should be allotted by FIS to train our coaches and athletes in Europe.
- (3) Some of promising Indian athletes in FIS races should be sponsored by FIS as well as the one in Europe to give them a better exposure.

In India's suggestion letter, they needed a special help for training, but there were no specific details. It was a classical appeal just asking for help. In past, these kinds of letters have been submitted a few times as well. As a matter of fact, it was too general and broad to handle. Indian delegate also admitted on this point. Therefore, Dr. Lee would discuss about this issue separately with India later.

Points For 14th Asian Ski Federation Congress In Cancun, Mexico 2016.

Dear Ms Lee,

1. Thank you for your mail asking for points from National Ski federations to be discussed during FIS conference at Cancun Mexico in Jun16.
2. As you are aware skiing is limited to few countries in our continent and few more countries who have potential are devoid of proper infrastructure. It results in overdependence of our athletes on European countries. Therefore I feel before we ask help from FIS we need to discuss the possible opportunities available to Asian countries within the continent and coordinate our training so that we can achieve tangible results at world level. I have not heard any such meet by our continental ski federation. Secondly I request our President to visit India and other such countries and advise our Govt. to develop the desired infrastructure. Asian Ski association is required to be more proactive to find talents from developing countries and train them with the help of their Govt. and other Asian countries with better skiing infrastructure. As we do not get any sponsors, you need to give special concessions to our ski athletes for FIS races within the continent.
3. As far as help from FIS is concerned, I think we should ask for more development camps and coaches in India as we do not get any Govt aid for such activities. Special vacancies should be allotted by FIS to train our coaches and promising athletes in Europe.
4. FIS should sponsor some of our promising athletes for FIS races as well in Europe to give them a better exposure.
5. I am very grateful to you for asking us the points so that we can raise the standards of our sport in our continent. I am sure we can discuss more positive things once we meet at Cancun.
6. You may kindly also note this e-mail address of mine and keep me in your mailing address in addition to WGFI.

5-2 Japan

Mr. Aki MURASATO, FIS Council Member gave a presentation on “Sport for Tomorrow” (<http://www.sport4tomorrow.jp/>).

This program is supported by the Japanese government to promote sports for more than 10 million people in 100 nations between 2014 and 2020, the year when Tokyo will host the Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games. This was the commitment of Japanese Prime Minister when Japan bid for Tokyo Olympics.

Through this program of “Sport for Tomorrow”, Japan invited Indian team of 5 people (2 athletes, 2 coaches, 1 official) for 10 days in March 2016. They participated at the FIS race in Japan. After the race, they went sightseeing to the heritage site of Japan. It was a unique project for ski developing country and also wonderful experience for its young ski athletes.

Any country can apply and join in this program. ASF member countries are highly recommended to utilize such an opportunity of ski training in Japan under this thankful program. Especially, Nepal who seeks for a training program can also participate in order to develop their ski skills.

The new academies invite young people from all over the world to develop tomorrow's leading administrators, coaches, and academics in sport. 18 months master course and 2 weeks short programmes are provided every year.

3. "PLAY TRUE 2020" – Develop sport integrity through strengthening the global anti-doping activities



"PLAY TRUE 2020" is to bring a long-lasting impact to enrich the lives of young people and the society with Play True values. By building the even stronger anti-doping capacity and network, it is aimed to protect and promote the sport integrity and the positive values through sport. Under the PLAY TRUE 2020, the following five activities are to be implemented: 1) global capacity building, 2) development of values-based education programme, 3) development of core professionals, 4) conducting social science research, and 5) hosting international conferences.

5-3 Mongolia

Mr. Chagnaa suggests 2 issues as follows.

- (1) To organize Asian Alpine Children Championship 2018 in Mongolia.
- (2) To nominate candidates of ASF Council Members from Mongolia.

Regarding above item (1), Mr. Chagnaa made a mistake because Asian Alpine Children Championship 2018 has already been decided to be held in Iran as a result of the decision at the 13th ASF Congress in Barcelona, Spain on June 4th, 2014.

Representative of Mongolia, Ms. Endene OCHIRSUREN, mentioned that it was impossible to organize Alpine Championships in Mongolia, but only possible for cross-country for children because of snow and terrain condition. She also informed that Mr. Chagnaa was a coach and he was not in the position to send formal correspondences to ASF representing the Mongolia Ski Federation, which was not admitted by Mongolian Ski Federation.

Therefore, all the official contacts should be made directly with Mongolia Ski Federation, not with Mr. Chagnaa in person. Dr. Lee advised her to have a good control within Mongolia domestically in regard to Mr. Chagnaa's matter.

5-4 Sites for the Asian Alpine Ski Championships in 2017 (Junior), 2018 (Licensed), 2019 (Children)

5-4-1 Site for the 26th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) in 2017

Lebanon is to organize the 26th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) in 2017.

5-4-2 Site for the 27th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Licensed) in 2018

Iran is to organize the 27th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Licensed) in 2018 as a result of the decision at the 13th ASF Congress in Barcelona, Spain on June 4th, 2014.

5-4-3 Site for the 28th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children) in 2019

Dr. Lee suggested China to organize the 28th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children) in 2019. Chinese Ski Association would discuss this matter internally in near future as they go back to China. They will send an e-mail about the final decision.

If China becomes unable to organize it, Iran will undertake the children championships in 2019.

6. Election of Officials (ASF Directors for 2016-2018)

The ASF assistant secretary general sent out an e-mail to ASF member countries on March 30th, 2016 asking about any changes in ASF council members for 2016-2018.

- (1) India proposed to change a director into Mr. DHILLON, JS (President, Winter Games Federation of India) as shown in Attachment 4.
- (2) Iran proposed no change in vice-president, Mr. SAVEHSHEMSHAKI, Eisa (Advisor, Iran Ski Federation) as shown in Attachment 5.
- (3) Japan proposed that Mr. Toshimasa FURUKAWA will be replaced by Mr. Toshiaki (Aki) MURASATO as vice-president, and the Ski Association of Japan didn't propose anyone for director nor secretary liaison as shown in Attachment 6.
- (4) Pakistan proposed to change a director into Mr. NAQVI, Qaswar Abbas (Secretary General, Ski Federation of Pakistan) as shown in Attachment 7.
- (5) Chinese Taipei proposed to change an auditor into Mr. KUO, Ming-Sheng as shown in Attachment 8.
- (6) Lebanon informed that the executive committee of the Lebanese Ski Federation decided to apply the candidature for the vice president Mr. KHALIL, Youssef of the Asian Ski Federation position as shown in Attachment 9.

As per vice presidency of ASF, both Lebanon and Iran applied for this position. According to the current ASF Constitution, 3 vice presidents were available. However, 4 vice presidents' positions were needed because of Lebanon's application.

To solve this issue, president and vice presidents' group of ASF discussed and concluded to increase the number of vice presidents up to 4 people from 3 people; 2 vice presidents from East of Asia and 2 vice presidents from West of Asia because Asian continent was fairly big. As result, Mr. KHALIL, Youssef of Lebanon was nominated as Vice President of ASF at this congress.

For this reason, Constitution of Asian Ski Federation should be amended with new concept as follows;

- A) The number of vice presidents is four, two from East of Asia and two from West of Asia, defining East region and West region of Asia bordering the Altai Mountains at west end of Mongolia.

Note: Based on current ASF member countries (16 countries)

- "East" includes: MGL, CHN, PRK, KOR, JPN, TPE
HKG (7 countries)
- "West" includes: KAZ, UZB, KGZ, TJK, IRA, LIB,
PAK, IND, NEP (9 countries)

- B) The member country, that is to apply for a vice president of ASF should have staged Asian Alpine Ski Championships at least three times as a criteria of the country's contribution to ASF. Vice presidency of ASF is to only be nominated from this qualified country.

Note: Based on current record of staging Asian Alpine Ski Championships in past since its start of 1991, it shows as follow.

Korea:	7 times
Japan:	5 times
Iran:	4 times
Lebanon:	4 times
Kazakhstan:	2 times
China:	2 times

- C) When the member of qualified countries in each region of the continent is more than three countries, two vice presidencies of the region alternate in sequence among the three or more countries at the time for every two years at the congress time.

Note: 1) Currently qualified countries:

- East: KOR, JPN
- West: IRA, LIB

- 2) This time, therefore, two vice presidents' application from two qualified countries (IRA, LIB) filled two vice president posts for 2016-2018 period.

- 3) As an example, if KAZ meets the qualification criteria of three Asian Alpine Ski Championships being achieved in near future and if they apply for a vice presidency of ASF, then two vice presidency posts would be rotated among the three countries (IRA, LIB, KAZ) in sequence in every two years such as in a sequence of 'IRA & LIB' – 'LIB & KAZ' – 'KAZ & IRA' – 'IRA & LIB' - etc.)
 - 4) LIB (Mr. Freddy KAIROUZ), IRA (Mr. Bahram SAVEHSHEMSHAKI) and PAK (Mr. Qaswar Abbas NAQVI) are to cooperate together as Working Group for amendment of ASF Constitution to contain above mentioned new concept and structure for election of four vice presidents of ASF. Once the working group completes this amendment, it will be ratified at next ASF congress in Greece in May 2018.
- (7) New ASF council members were elected at this congress and the new list of ASF directors and officials for 2016-2018 is presented in Attachment 10.

5. Comments:

- (1) The 24th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Licensed) was held at Yongpyong ski resort in Gangwon province, Korea, where is the site for the 2018 PyeongChang Olympic Winter Games. It was a good opportunity for competitors to experience the 2018 Olympic course for GS and SL.
- (2) All the participants stayed at the Dragon Valley Hotel inside the resort, and the food was served at Chalet restaurant from a light buffet breakfast to a traditional full course western cuisine dinner in this western style restaurant. Lunch was available at both the Dragon Peak restaurant on the top of mountain and Gerende restaurant at Dragon Plaza on the bottom of the Gondola base area as well.
- (3) Yongpyong Resort was born in 1975 as the first ever modern ski resort facility in Korea, which is located at a range of 700m ~ 1,458m high. It did innovate a new leisure ski culture in Korea becoming as "Korea's Ski Mecca" with a growing reputation as an internationally-renown resort owing to 4 FIS Alpine World Cups of 1998, 2000, 2003 and 2006.

- (4) Iran team was the largest participation with 4 man racers, 6 lady racers, 2 coaches and 3 officials, Mr. Soolegahni (Secretary General), Mr. Ebrhimi (Representative of the Ministry of Sports), Mr. Mohsenpourolmaghni (Media).
- (5) The president of Kyrgyzstan Ski Federation was present as the coach for their team. It is notable that a Kyrgyzstan man racer got the 4th place in GS.
- (6) Mongolia team and Lebanon team arrived at Yongpyong resort very late evening so they didn't have a chance to train on the slope. They felt that "Rainbow" course was quite challenging to them. A Lebanon man racer had a minor injury. He got his shoulder dislocated during the 1st run in GS, but it was not that serious.
- (7) Usually less than 4 racers from Nepal had participated at the ASF championships in past. However, this time unprecedentedly 5 racers (1 racer on his own expense) participated to experience the Olympic slope, and Mr. Bijaya, Secretary of Nepal Ski Association was present as well.
- (8) Mr. Mussarat Ali, Secretary General of Pakistan Ski Federation and Mr. Toshimasa Furukawa (Japan), Vice President of Asian Ski Federation were present and they had an opportunity to tour around Alpensia ski resort which is the site for the ski jump and cross-country for the 2018 Olympic Winter Games.
- (9) The weather was clear with temperature -5°C when GS was conducted on "Rainbow" slope. However, on the next day for SL competition, temperature dropped down to -10°C with strong wind of about 15-20 m/sec. Therefore, gondolas stopped operating, and site for SL was moved to "Silver" slope with a chairlift from "Rainbow".
- (10) A newsman from KBS-TV reported about the championship. It went on air on the 9 o'clock news reporting as a small test event for the 2018 PyeongChang Olympic Winter Games.
- (11) POCOG (2018 PyeongChang Organizing Committee) Sports Department dispatched its Alpine Sports Manager to the RC to help and be trained with race operation of the championships. The sports manager brought 20 race crew members, some from POCOG Sports Department and others from local ski clubs at POCOG's expense. It was surely a good coordination between POCOG Sports Department and OC of the Asian Alpine Ski Championships.

5. Comments:

- (1) The 25th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children) was held at Mzaar ski resort in Lebanon organized by the Lebanese Ski Federation under the Asian Ski Federation.
- (2) The U14 and U16 categories were organized at Mzaar Intercontinental Hotel. FIS TD changed the competition slope to this new site from a previous training slope because snow condition was not good enough to conduct the championships.
- (3) 8 Asian countries took part in the championships: India, Kazakhstan Kyrgyzstan, South Korea, Lebanon, Mongolia, Nepal, Pakistan. In addition, Cyprus ski team (3 boys, 4 girls and 1 coach) also participated as a guest nation because TD was from Cyprus. One Cyprus girl racer got the 2nd place in GS at U14 category, but no medal was awarded because they are not the member of ASF member country.
- (4) In India, any national league was not conducted in 2015/2016 season due to lack of snow. No racers have been selected in this season. Participating athletes to Lebanon were selected in last season.
- (5) Kazakhstan athletes were not from national ski team but from private ski club this time. However, a girl racer got the bronze medal in GS at U14 category.

- (6) There was very big participation from Lebanon. 44 boy and 31 girl racers participated. Four gold medals were awarded to two boys and two girls at U14 category in SL & GS.
- (7) A boy racer of Nepal had a training program in Japan to participate in the championships. There is no ski resort in Nepal, therefore Nepal team usually goes to overseas for training.
- (8) Taipei team could not participate because they had no children racers this time. Uzbekistan team did not take part in because of unstable political situation in Lebanon.
- (9) Since the snow started to melt at noon, only one run conducted at U14 category for the safety of small children. Although 10 girl racers out of 23 girls at U16 category in SL did not reach the finish line in the reason of “Did Not Start”, “Did Not Finish”, Disqualified”, two runs (1st & 2nd run) have been completed without any injury under good guidance of TD.
- (10) Prize giving ceremony for SL was conducted at a hall of Chateau D’eau Hotel where all the participants stayed during the championships. After the ceremony, a formal dinner was served in Lebanese style. The prize award for GS was given at the bottom of the slope at Mzaar Intercontinental Hotel.
- (11) The Lebanese Ski Federation conducted the opening ceremony on the afternoon of the 4th of March at Mzaar Intercontinental Hotel including an international style lunch in the same hotel. The president of the Lebanese Ski Federation, Mr. Charbel SALAME said “The federation is pursuing the preparations to make the championships a successful one thanks to the General of the Lebanese Army, Jean KAHWAJI, who is supporting this event as well as our sponsors”
- (12) The championships were organized under the patronage of the Lebanese Army Commander General Jean KAHWAJI with the presence of the Ministry of Sports, Ministry of Tourist, the presidents of the 31 Clubs (family of ski), the presidents of 5 Municipalities ; the CEOs of the 5 Ski Resorts in Lebanon.
- (12) The opening ceremony was covered by the Lebanese Media’s and the 2 days races (SL & GS) were covered “Live” by 1 TV (future TV). It was notable that the TV covered the races Live for the first time in Lebanon.
- (13) The championships were well organized despite of the warm weather. It was very exciting that Asian young ski lovers got together at the championships under FIS Development Program. Especially, Lebanese Ski Federation was quite enthusiastic to make the championships enjoyable in a festive mood.

CONSTITUTION OF ASIAN SKI FEDERATION

Art 1. (Name)

The name of the organization is “Asian Ski Federation” and is abbreviated as ASF.

Art 2. (Purpose)

The purpose of the organization is to organize a network of Ski Associations/Federations to exchange information regarding FIS activities and work together for the betterment of ski techniques and the development of all skiing activities, as well as the further the friendship among the Ski Associations/Federations of Asia.

Art 3. (Membership)

Membership will be open to Ski Associations/Federations of Asia subject to the followings on approval by the ASF Congress;

- 3.1 Applicants who are current members of the International Ski Federation (FIS/IVS).
- 3.2 Applicants who are not members of FIS/IVS must meet the following criteria duly certified by their National Olympic Committee (NOC);
 - 3.2.1 Must collectively represent the ski associations of the country.
 - 3.2.2 Must be recognized as the sole representative of the sport by the respective National Olympic Committee.
 - 3.2.3 Must conduct competitions at the national level with participation from its member associations.
 - 3.2.4 Must provide a copy of its organization along with the names of its member associations.
- 3.3 Affiliate membership may be granted to nations whose applications are being processed for approval on those that are in the development stage and have yet to meet the basic criteria.
 - 3.3.1 Affiliate members may be invited to attend the ASF Congress as observers, but do not have the voting right.

Art 4. (Withdrawal)

A Member Association/Federation will be automatically excluded if it applies for withdrawal of membership in writing.



Art 5. (Officials)

(1) Delegates:

Each Ski Association/Federation shall be represented by two delegates at the annual conference, hereafter called the Congress. The Congress is the legislative organ of this organization.

(2) Council Members:

The Council is elected by the vote of the delegates at the Congress. A Council member cannot be a member of the Council and a delegate to Congress at the same time. If a Association/Federation Delegate is elected to a Council Member, that Ski Association/Federation must send another member as a Delegate.

Art 6. (Council)

Council is the executive organ of the organization and consists of the following members.

(1) President:

The President represents and commends whole activities of this organization. President chairs the Congress and Council and has a decisive vote when pro and con are even.

(2) Vice President:

Up to 3 Vice Presidents support President and in case the president is absent or unable to carry out his duties, one of the Vice President will take over the duties of the President. Vice President may not belong to same Association/Federation as President.

(3) Member:

Up to 8 members representing different Association/Federation will be elected as Director.

(4) Secretary General:

Secretary General is appointed by President and responsible for the managerial works related to the activities organized.

(5) Non-standing Member:

Non-standing member may present at the Council and Congress but with no voting right.

(a) Honorary Member:

Honorary member group may express their opinions to Presidents.

(b) Auditor:

Two auditors are in charge of auditing the financial reports and activities and reporting at the Council and Congress.

Art 7. (Terms of Officials)

The Terms for officials are two years. Each official and the Council Member are re-eligible at will.



Art 8. (Conference)

- (1) The Congress and the council will be held every spring; provided, however, in years when either the Asian Winter Games or the FIS International Congress is held, the Congress will be held at the same time and the site. The time and place of the Congress will be determined one year in advance. The President shall notify the Members of the Council and Delegates of the congress of the time and place of the Meetings.
- (2) If a Member cannot attend, his/her ski Association/Federation may appoint another person to attend instead. The topics of discussion at the meeting of the Council shall be submitted to the Council from the Congress. The Council meets, at the invitation of the President, as the business requires.

Art 9. (Expenditures and Fees)

The expenditures of this organization shall be covered by membership fees plus contributions. The annual membership fee is US\$ 300 to be paid at the time of the annual Congress. This fee covers office expenses and other minor expenses. The delegate of their respective ski Association/Federations will be responsible for all expenses related to attending the annual Congress.

Art 10. (Amendment)

This Constitution will become effective upon approval at the Congress and amendments can be made only at the Congress.

Art 11. (Secretariat)

- (1) The Secretariat will be located within the office of the Ski Associations/Federations of the President and a few liaison offices will be established when necessary.
- (2) The official language is English.

Art 12. (Others)

Any matters, which are not covered by this Constitution, shall be prevailed by FIS Statutes, Regulations and decisions from the Council and Congress.
