1. Roll-Call for Participants & Congress

- 15 member countries out of 16 member countries were present.
 - Tajikistan was absent.
 - 1 Observer from Hungary
- Quorum met
 - Opening of the congress was announced.

2. Greetings (Welcome Speech by Dr. Sung-Won Lee, President, ASF)

This time, 15 countries out of 16 ASF member countries were present. Dr. Lee sincerely welcomed all the participants and thanked for the large participation.

Mr. Eisa Savehshemshaki, Vice-president of ASF was introduced because he has been elected the Deputy Minister of Winter Sports of Iran Sports Ministry and left his position of the president of Iran Ski Federation. He served as the President of the Ira Ski Federation for the last 30 years. However, due to the increased duties of his new role, he will step aside from presidency. He is the history of Iran Ski Federation and did much contribution in developing ski in Iran. Taking this opportunity, Dr. Lee would like to congratulate his promotion.

Since last congress in Korea in 2012, we had the most important event this year, Sochi Winter Olympic Games. As you all know, we had a great, gigantic and extravagant Olympic games. It is good to witness a big Olympic legacy because geographically Sochi is close to the eastern part of Europe and some western part of Asia. Furthermore, the ski venues are extraordinary thanks to great natural environment, big mountains and terrains. After the Winter Olympic Games, we will continue to enjoy ski facilities later on for years to come in future.

The ASF events of the championships for children and juniors were both successful. Particularly, Children Championships in Chimbulak, Kazakhstan in 2013 were well supported by the government and business sponsor. It was unique that gold medalists were given Samsung Mobile Phone as a prize this time. I would like to thank Kazakhstan Ski Federation for such organization and their efforts.

The speed events (SG and SG combined) were conducted during the Junior Championships in Dizin, Iran in 2014 coinciding with the special speed training camp for well-chosen boys and girls supported by FIS Solidarity Fund. Dr. Lee would like Iran Ski Federation to keep up this speed events and training camp more workable and effective in future as times go by. Dr. Lee cordially requested good cooperations among participating delegates for efficient proceeding of the meeting.

3. Acceptance of Official Minutes of the 12th ASF Congress

The minutes of the 12th ASF congress in Hig1 Resort, Kangwonland, Gangwon Province, Korea on May 28th, 2012 were unanimously accepted. The minutes had been circulated to member countries on July 18th, 2012 and there were no other comments.

4-2 Report on the 22nd Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children) in Kazakhstan in 2013

The 22nd Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children) was held at the Chimbulak Symbulak ski resort in Almaty, Kazakhstan during February 27th – 28th, 2013 under a subsidy program of FIS Development Program. The championships resulted in the participation with the 10 Asian Ski Federation member countries (IRA, KAZ, KGZ, KOR, LIB, MGL, NEP, PAK, TPE, UZB) with 75 racers and 23 foreign coaches and officials.

Kyrgyzstan participated at the Asian Alpine Ski Championship for the first time since their full membership of Asian Ski Federation in 2008.

The FIS Development Program supported airfare for 4 racers and 1 official per each nation. A report on the championships to FIS by Dr. Sung-Won Lee is attached.

Dr. Lee would like to thank for the effort of the Kazakhstan Ski Federation in regard to local business sponsors for the championships because all medalists were given 4 items (Medal, Cup, Certificate and Prize Present). Especially, it was the first time that mobile phones (Samsung) were given to all gold medalists as a prize present during the Asian Alpine Ski Championships.

4-3 Report on the 23rd Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) in Iran in 2014

The 23rd Asian Junior Alpine Ski Championships was held at Dizin ski resort in Iran. The championships resulted in the participation with the 9 Asian Ski Federation member countries (IND, IRA, KAZ, KOR, LIB, MGL, NEP, TJK, UZB) with 68 racers and 10 foreign coaches and officials. It was unfortunate that Japan and D.P.R Korea could not participate this time.

Speed training camp were conducted coinciding with the Junior Championships. It was a good opportunity for ASF member countries and very successful race. Many countries asked to continue this kind of speed training camp again. However, the main problem was not all the racers did have the speed events' skis. Some alpine ski leading countries are using SG skis while others do not have such ski. We need to think about some appropriate solution to this problem.

Another problem was that there was difference in level of skiing between member countries. Some countries still need basic training yet but some other countries are more advanced. Therefore, speed events should be conducted for the development of their skills.

Dr. Lee proposed to share ski equipments. When advanced racers have a chance to change their skis, their old ski equipment could be given to lower level racers of other less advanced nations. It would be one way to solve this kind of problem without financial burden. More study and discussions are to be needed.

5. Discussions

5-1 India

India suggests 3 issues.

- To have the first FIS race (Alpine) at Auli ski resort in India in 2014/15 under the guidance of Asian Ski Federation in regard to the technical and financial management, and assured participation from ASF member countries.
- In need of assistance to get homologation for Cross-country competition as a FIS race.
- To hold the next Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Juniors) under technical guidance and support by FIS.

The above matters would be continuously discussed later. Dr. Lee proposed Winter Games Federation of India to send more detailed informations of Auli ski resort in regard to all the pertinent conditions for staging an Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) in near future. We will continue to study the feasibility if it is possible. The homologation issue for cross-country course needs to be directly addressed to FIS.

5-2 Mongolia

Mongolia suggests 2 issues.

- To host Asian Championships in Mongolia.
- To nominate Mr. Ts. BAASANDORJ as ASF council member (director).

Mongolian Ski Federation introduced general brief information of their structure. They have 3 committees – Alpine, Snowboard and Cross-Country. Mongolian Ski Federation had a plan for the development of ski slopes to hold the Asian Championships in Mongolia. Dr. Lee encouraged them in their nice developments so that they could stage the championships in future.

Prior to the congress, Mr. Dorjgotov Chagnaa filed a report by e-mail, as shown in Attachment 2, about the progress of a ski resort “Olympic Height Resort” in Mongolia. It is indeed encouraging to hear such a progress in Mongolia. Mr. Chagnaa has been representing Mongolia for long time since early 1991 and participating Asian Alpine Ski Championships all along over the years. He is supposedly representing the Alpine Ski Association of Mongolia as the president. It would be appreciated if Mongolian Ski Federation represented at this congress could file a report e-mail explaining the situation.

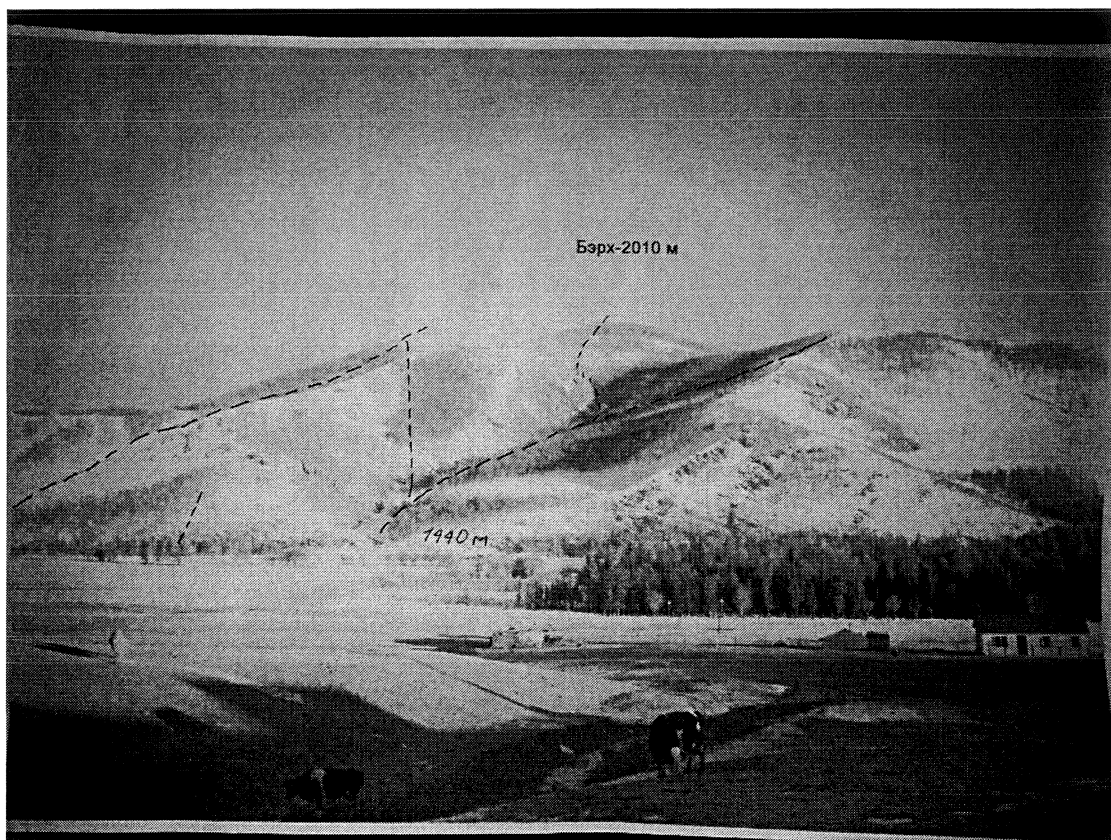

5-3 Sites for the Asian Alpine Ski Championships in 2016 (Children), 2017 (Juniors), 2018 (Men or Ladies)

5-3-1 Site for the 24th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Men or Ladies) in 2015

5-3-1-1 This will be the first “Licensed Championships” in the history of ASF. Yongpyong ski resort in Korea is the site for the 2018 Winter Olympic Games so it would be a good opportunity for racers to experience the Olympic slopes.

According to the decision at the 12th ASF congress at Kangwonland Hotel in Korea on May 28th, 2012, the first licensed championships for Men or Ladies will be held in Korea for the first time in 2015.

The first prototype alpine championships (Licensed) of Asian Ski Federation is to be held at Yongpyong Resort, Korea, which is under detailing. The Yongpyong’s Rainbow course is the competition site for GS and SL of 2018 PyeongChang Olympic Winter Games. The details will be notified later by the organizer of Korea.

5-3-1-2 The age limit for the Licensed category will be between 17 years old and 27 years old. FIS Development Program can support up to 27 years old. For the final decision, Dr. Lee will discuss the age limit with FIS.

According to the FIS Competition Rule, the age category of the Licensed international competition is stipulated as “1998 and earlier” (17 years old and older) for the first part of 2015. The FIS Rule for Limits on Competitions (ICR 607.3) gives no upper age limit to the licensed competition category.

In consideration of facts that Asian Ski Federation stresses more emphasis on development of skiing for youth and younger generations, and Asian Alpine Championships bears special feature of sizable financial support for international flight travel expenses through FIS Development Program, it is desirable to restrict of the upper age limit of the licensed championships to 27 years old (1988 for the first season of 2015).

After a series of discussions, involving Mr. Freddy Keyrouz of Lebanon and Mr. Bahram Shemshaki of Iran, both experts specially in alpine ski, it is agreed that under the financial support of FIS Development Program, the age bracket of the licensed Asian Alpine Championships is (17 years old – 27 years old), that is (1998-1988) for the first part of 2015 in northern hemisphere.

Also, it is further agreed that in order to give a chance of participation to the prototype of championships for little elder racers, the bracket of 28 years old to 30 years old is permitted to participate the championships at their own expenses in both international travel cost and accommodation cost. This will be applied from the first ASF's "Licensed" category Asian Alpine Ski Championships in Korea in early 2015, under a general understanding and approved of FIS.

5-3-2 Site for the 25th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children) in 2016

Lebanon has applied to organize Children Championships in 2016.

5-3-3 Site for the 26th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Juniors) in 2017

India proposed to organize the Junior Championships in 2017.

An intensive and fast study will be carried out with speed supply of detailed pertinent informations about “Auli Ski Resort” for a feasibility study to come to an appropriate decision in near future.

In case Auli is proved to be inappropriate, an alternative country will be sought immediately.

5-3-4 Site for the 27th Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Men or Ladies) in 2018

Iran proposed to organize the Licensed Championships in 2018.





5. Comments:

- (1) The 22nd Asian Alpine Ski Championships was held at Shymbulak Ski Resort where is located in the Zailiyskiy Alatau mountain at 2260 m above sea level. It is 25 km from the city center of Almaty City. An average temperature is -7°C in the winter. Ski season normally begins in December and can run into April. Winter is warmer in Shymbulak than in city. Shymbulak has blue sky, bright sun and crystal clear white snow in winter. Almost natural snow in Shymbulak consists of very low rate of artificial snow because snow cannons are used only in the very beginning of ski season.
- (2) The base area (2260 m) of the Shymbulak ski slopes are served by cable car from "Medeu", lower access area (1691 m). This cable car is the world's third-longest cable car with a length of 4.5 km. It takes about 20 minutes to reach the snow skiing base area on a new cable car line. The majestic mountain views with snowy slopes, and evergreen trees are spectacular scenery. It was also a good opportunity for children racers to experience its new facilities – a new cable car to go up to Shymbulak ski resort from lower area of Shymbulak at Medeu, and another new gondola to go up to mountain top from the base.
- (3) The Medeu is an outdoor speed skating arena where is located in a mountain valley (Medeu Valley) at 1691 m above sea level, making it the highest skating rink in the world. Shymbulak including Medeu was renovated and reconstructed for the 2011 Asian Winter Games. The high altitude skating rink Medeu and Shymbulak ski resort have become the landmarks of Kazakhstan.
- (4) All cableways at Shymbulak makes one system, allowing the skiers to reach the highest point of the ski resort, the Talgar pass – 3200 m above sea level. It takes 40 minutes all the way from Medeu to Talgar. Its other peaks are Shkolnik – 3800 m, and Chkalov – 3500 m above sea level. There is also Snow-Park for snowboarding.

[22nd Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Children)]

- (5) Uzbekistan and Iran team stayed at Medeu. They had breakfast and dinner there. Only lunch was served at Shymbulak due to competitions. Other teams stayed at Shymbulak during the championships.
- (6) Indian failed to participate at the championships this time because there was a problem in getting visa due to late application to organizing committee in Kazakhstan.
- (7) There was a mistake in competition management in regard to "Reverse" on the 2nd Run in GS. In case of Korea, a girl racer Ms. Rim was at the 1st rank of the 1st Run. She should have run as the 15th racer at the 2nd Run. However, she ran as the 30th racer at the 2nd Run due to the mistake in "Reverse". Nevertheless, she got the gold medal at last.
- (8) It was found that poles were set too deeply, which was dangerous for racers because it might cause their knee injuries. After discussion during team captains' meeting, pole settings were changed next day. In result, GS competition started a little late in about 20-30 minutes, however, there was no injury problem during the competition.
- (9) For all medalists, 4 items (Medal, Cup, Certificate and Prize Present) were given to them. Prize presents were prepared by local sponsors for each gold, silver and bronze medalist. Especially, it was the first time that mobile phones (Samsung) were given to all gold medalists as a prize present during the Asian Alpine Ski Championships.
- (10) At the prize giving ceremony, some prizes were awarded by Mr. Lev Tsoy, Head of Internal Communications Department of Technodom Company and by Mr. Spitsin Sergey, Representative from Shymbulak Ski Resort.
- (11) During the opening ceremony, Mr. Khairbolat Khaidarov, Head of the Department of Physical Culture & Sports of Almaty City, and Mr. Yerzhan Yerkinbayev, General Director of Shymbulak Ski Resort were present.
- (12) Kyrgyzstan participated at the Asian Alpine Ski Championship for the first time since their full membership of Asian Ski Federation in 2008.
- (13) Taiwan team arrived at Shymbulak for training a couple of days earlier than the championships because there was no ski resort in Taiwan to train.

5. Comments:

- (1) The 23rd Asian Alpine Ski Championships (Junior) was held at Dizin ski resort which is located in central Alborz Mountains along the northern border of Iran. Dizin is the largest ski resort in Iran and is located 123km by road north of Tehran in the Gajereh region. Dizin offers a long ski season from late November until late May, because of high altitude, ranging from 2700 m base to 3600 m top, and good snow. The Alborz Mountains contain several peaks over 4,000 m, where the highest peak is the volcano Mount Damavand at 5,671 m. Dizin Resort started officially in the winter of 1969. It takes 3 hours from Teheran International airport to Dizin.
- (2) There are two hotels at the bottom of the slope. Since early 2008, one of these hotels has been closed for renovation and now is open. The hotel is located just 50 m from the bottom of the slopes. Hotels at base area are situated at altitude of 2600 m. Dizin ski resort is also an important grass-ski center during summer for FIS races.

- (3) The longest run from top to bottom is 7.5 kilometers, considered as the longest skiable run in the Middle East area. The length of the Gondola from the base to the top of the mountain is 3.7 kilometers. The highest ski lift reaches 3600 m, making it one of the 40 highest ski resorts in the world.

There are no artificial snow making facilities. Dizin has normally a big snowfall in winter due to the Caspian sea at north and because of its high altitude and northward facing, the snow remains for longer period in season. The temperature on the slopes during the championships was - 3°C which was a little milder this year and mostly sunny weather.

Thanks to the very good snow quality and substantial vertical drop, this resort was excellent for the Super G competition with challenging slopes. The snow conditions were usually good.

- (4) It was really successful championships which included Super G and Super G Combined on such challenging alpine pistes which were totally covered with complete white snow without any trees. These disciplines were conducted for the second time at Dizin ski resort for the Asian Alpine Ski Championships.
- (5) The prize giving ceremony took place at a square in front of the hotel. Iran performed the best, obtaining 8 gold medals out of 16 available, achieving Nation's Cup, rank 1st. Iran was really jubilant, for which they deserved.
- (6) A man racer from Iran got a mild injury on his shoulder in the SL competition, and he was moved to a hospital because his shoulder was dislocated. However, it was not that serious.
- (7) There was a change in the organization of Iran Ski Federation. Now, Mr. Nasser Talebi who was vice president of federation is acting as provisional president of the federation until election in spring. There was not any change in secretary general position as yet, so Mr. Ali Sologhani will continue his position until the election. Therefore, 4 years period of Mr. Eisa Savehshemshaki as president is finished, and he has been appointed as Deputy of Sport Minister in Winter Sports and Development. He decided to cancel his candidature for federation presidency position after about 30 years service as president of Iran Ski Federation.

- (8) The Iran Ski Federation has received financial support of FIS Solidarity Fund to conduct a Speed Training Camp for the first time coinciding with the 23rd Asian Alpine Ski Championships in Dizin. It was an extremely good opportunity for racers and coaches to have training and lessons by special coaches. A detailed report from Iran Ski Federation about the execution of the project will be directly submitted to FIS.
